The Danube Bend creating Hungary's finest landscape is where the river passes between the hills and turns towards the south. Formerly the property of the Crown, this land was the scene of major historic events in Medieval Hungary.



Three small old towns crown the picturesque Danube Bend:

Szentendre - a unique artists' town, Visegrád - a former royal seat, Esztergom - the former capital of Hungary.



It is an extremely scenic area with green valleys and hills rising up from the river, picturesque little towns with market squares and commanding fortresses with sweeping views.

The day trip takes you to Visegrád, with its medieval citadel and romantic ruins of the former royal residence. Then it's on to Esztergom for an interior visit of the town's famous cathedral. After enjoying a three-course lunch with coffee, you will continue on to the Baroque artists' village of Szentendre.

The Danube bend is perfect for daytrips for those who want to see more of Hungary outside its capital.
