Eger and its surroundings played a memorable part in Hungarian history when a small Hungarian army halted a major Turkish military expedition in 1552.

The relics of Hungarian history, the wonderful location, the cultural life, the medicinal spa waters and baths attract many visitors from home and abroad to this mellow old town. And of course, the wines!

Viticulture began in the region as early as the 11th century and over the past decade, the wine growers of Eger have demonstrated both here and abroad that :

Leányka, Kékfrankos, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon of course „Egri bikavér” (Eger's bull's blood wine) wines are equal to the challenge of both domestic and foreign competitors.



The tour takes you to the baroque-style town and also to the historical wine region of Eger by visiting the basilica, the famous castle from the 16th century and the baroque town centre and having lunch in the „Beautiful lady's valley. Afterwards you will have the possibility of take part in a wine tasting or purchase a bottle of unique wine before returning to Budapest.
